## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Language of instruction	Courses for exchange students: English
	If students are fluent in German they may also take courses taught in
	German.
Language requirements	To ensure students' optimal success, all incoming exchange students*
	are required to take an online English test during the application
	process. This test will be <b>provided by MCI</b> and is free of charge.
	Information on the test and the required minimum score (equivalent to
	B2 level according to the Common European Framework of Reference
	for Languages) will be provided during the application period.
	Alternatively, if students have already taken any of the following
	standardized English language tests and acquired the specified results,
	they will be exempted from our online English test.
	<ul> <li>Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL): TOEFL iBT - minimum sore 85, TOEFL PBT - minimum score 550 <u>https://www.ets.org/toefl</u></li> <li>International English Language Testing System (IELTS): minimum overall band score 6.0. <u>www.ielts.org</u></li> <li>Cambridge English Business Vantage (BEC Vantage): A/B in all four skills; alternatively, students may submit a BEC Higher exam result. <u>http://www.cambridgeenglish.org/</u></li> <li>Cambridge English Advanced (CAE): A/B in all four skills; alternatively, students may submit a CPE exam result. <u>http://www.cambridgeenglish.org/</u></li> </ul>
	*Students whose native language is English or who are enrolled in a program fully taught in English at their home university are not required to take our online English test or to submit a standardized English language test result when applying to MCI. This also applies to French-Canadian students.
	If students are fluent in German and wish to take courses taught in
	German, MCI reserves the right to test their German language skills in
	a telephone interview.

Application procedure and deadlines	Partner universities are asked to <b>nominate</b> their outgoing <b>students by</b>
	e-mail ( <u>incoming@mci.edu</u> ) at least one month prior to the application
	deadline so that students have enough time to appear for the online
	English test and finish their applications by the deadline. The
	nomination e-mail should contain the following information:

	Gender
	Level (undergraduate/bachelor or graduate/master)
	<ul> <li>Field of study (e.g. business, tourism, engineering, etc.)</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Semester student wishes to study at MCI (fall or spring)</li> </ul>
	Language proficiency test result (TOEFL, IELTS, etc.), if
	available
	After MCI has received the nomination e-mail, we will email your
	students the information on how to apply online approximately one
	month before the application deadline. They will also get the link to our
	online English test that they need to complete during the application
	period (if they have not already taken a TOEFL/IELTS, etc.). Supporting
	documents needed for applying online:
	Official transcript of records in English from home institution
	Digital passport photo (optional)
	Language proficiency test result (TOEFL, IELTS, etc.) <u>OR</u> online
	English test provided by MCI
	Students will select their courses and create their learning agreements
	when applying online. They then have to get their learning agreements
	signed by their coordinator and upload their signed agreements onto
	our application website.
	Application deadlines for exchange students
	Applications for fall semester: May 15
	Applications for spring semester: November 15
	Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.
	Once students have completed their applications and MCI has
	processed and approved their applications, students will get an
	acceptance e-mail after the application deadline. In addition, citizens of
	countries outside the EU/EEA/Switzerland will get an acceptance
	letter so that they can apply for an Austrian visa and/or residence
	permit.
	We kindly ask students to carefully read the information on our website
	and to check their e-mails regularly.

Visa requirements	Citizens of countries outside the EU/EEA/Switzerland have to apply for
·	an Austrian visa and/or residence permit in their home country prior to

Health insurance	MCI does not offer a university health insurance; <b>students</b> are
	responsible for obtaining international health insurance valid
	throughout their stay in Austria/Europe prior to their arrival; MCI
	reserves the right to demand proof of insurance.

Which courses can students take?	Regular coursesStudents may choose courses from ONE degree program. They may supplement these courses with courses from our International Program (optional).Undergraduate/bachelor level students cannot take courses from a master's degree program.
	Language courses MCI's Language Center offers language courses during the semester

	including a German language course at various levels. These courses
	are subject to a fee of approximately EUR 100 and are offered subject
	to the number of applicants per level.
Number of ECTS credits exchange	Exchange students may take courses up to 30 ECTS credits per
students may take per semester	semester (= full course load). Most exchange students take courses up
	to 15 - 30 ECTS credits per semester.
Grades	In Austria, grades range from 1 to 5; 1 is excellent and 5 is a fail; grade
	4 is still a pass.
	Grade 1: excellent (90% and more points achieved)
	Grade 2: good (between 80% and 89% of points achieved)
	Grade 3: satisfactory (between 70% and 79% of points achieved)
	Grade 4: sufficient (between 60% and 69% of points achieved)
	Grade 5: Fail (less than 60% of points achieved)
Transcript of records	After completing their studies at MCI Innsbruck, every student is
	entitled to an official Transcript of Records. The Transcript of Records
	will be sent in a PDF format directly to the International Office of the
	home institution. An original transcript will be sent via post upon
	specific request only.

#### HOUSING

Housing	Most exchange students book a room in a student dorm via the
	Austrian Exchange Service (OeAD). OeAD arranges rooms in student
	dorms and students pay their monthly rent accordingly. This is the
	easiest and most convenient way to find relatively inexpensive
	housing.
	MCI cooperates with the student dorm "Internationales
	Studentenhaus" (ISH). Exchange students can book a room at ISH
	directly through MCI.
	Finding <b>private housing</b> in Innsbruck is challenging, especially at the
	beginning of a new semester. Nevertheless, students who are willing
	to invest considerable time and effort may be able to find a room in a
	shared apartment or a studio.
