BRICS Educational Internship Program is held in recognition of the Russian 2020 BRICS Presidency. The Program is a semester educational internship organized by the Far Eastern Federal University (FEFU), designed to provide an environment for students from Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa to study together in the framework of educational programs that could be evaluated as the most popular and relevant for BRICS. It promotes academic and cultural exchange aimed at intensification of socio-humanitarian cooperation, strengthening dialogue and mutual understanding within BRICS member states.

The Program offers students from BRICS countries to study in FEFU Master/Bachelor degree programs during spring semester (mid-February - June 2020). Studying together, students from five countries will get a chance to discuss the global agenda relevant for BRICS, as well as to explore Russia's foreign policy and its role in BRICS. The official language of the Program is English.

CONTENT OF THE PROGRAM

Winners of the Competition will be offered to study as part of one of the following **FEFU educational programs**:

1. **International Relations** (Bachelor Program) / **Russia in the Asia-Pacific: Politics, Economics, Security** (Master Program)
 2. **General Medicine** (Bachelor or Specialist Program) / **Improving Healthcare Outcomes in Chronic Diseases** (Master Program)
 3. **Cybersecurity** (Master Program)
 4. **International Business and Project Management** (Master Program)
 5. **Aquatic Biological Research** (Master Program)
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ABOUT COMPETITION

Winners

The competition implies selecting 100 students from Brazilian, Indian, Chinese and South African universities (25 people from each country) to take part in the Internship Program. FEFU will reimburse travel expenses (round trip to Vladivostok, Russia; economy class, limits imply) and waive the accommodation fee (double rooms in FEFU campus dormitories), as well as tuition fee. Participants are responsible for covering their visa and medical insurance expenses, meals while attending the Program and other expenses.

Reimbursement policy

Reimbursements will be distributed upon participants' arrival to Vladivostok and will be paid in Russian rubles. Please note, that travel expenses cannot be reimbursed in case of cancelling attendance. Travel expenses are reimbursed up to established maximums. Despite the reimbursement amounts are assumed to be sufficient for traveling, the Organizing Committee of the Program recognizes that in some cases they may not fully cover all travel costs.

Requirements to applicants

- Citizenship and current state of residence: Brazil, India, China and South Africa
- Status: master (1st year) or bachelor (3rd year) students;
- Interest in BRICS studies;
- English language level: upper intermediate
- Enrolled in the university, which has MoU and Student Exchange Agreement with FEFU*

After results' announcement winners of the Competition are responsible to promptly communicate with FEFU representatives on organizational matters. They are also required to follow deadlines and instructions from FEFU concerning application for Russian visa and other important issues.

*MoU and SEA if non-existent between participating home University and FEFU need to be negotiated before final results announcement

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

In order to take part in the Competition participants need to fill in online *Application form*, attaching:


- Scan of *passport* (main page indicating your name and photo);
- *Portrait photo* against a white background;
- *Academic transcript* properly verified by home university;
- CV (in English, not exceeding 2 pages);
- Link to a *video message* (in English), describing why they should be selected and how they will use experience gained at FEFU Internship Programme to further contribute to development of BRICS at their local levels;
- *Two letters of recommendation* signed and stamped by university representatives (in English, each not exceeding 2 pages).

Competition application ***deadline is October 15, 2019.***

The winners will be contacted by FEFU representatives ***no later than December, 1.***

Bachelor Program “International Relations”

Major International Relations

Brief Information The goal of the program is to train international relations professionals to work in the countries of the Asia-Pacific Region and South Asia and interact with other domestic and foreign academic programs within the framework of interdisciplinary and competence-based approaches and the development of a flexible educational environment. The academic program involves the preparation of specialists able to work in the following areas: communication, information and communication technologies (in the areas of: organizational and communication activities to ensure diplomatic, foreign economic and other contacts with foreign countries and regions; intercultural communication; translation activities; conducting official and business correspondence in a foreign language(s).

Master Program “Russia in the Asia-Pacific: Economics, Politics, Security ”

Major International Relations

Brief information The program has a cross-disciplinary curriculum, offering courses in diverse fields, such as Political science, International political economy, security studies, regional studies, law, languages, and Intercultural communication.

The program provides students with knowledge about international relations of Asia-Pacific, about Russia’s foreign policy, Russian Far East and its multi-faceted engagement with the Asia-Pacific important processes and trends in the contemporary world politics. Specialist (Bachelor) Program “General Medicine”

Major

General Medicine

Brief Information

The aim of the program is training of international-class clinical medicine specialists who solve complex diagnostic tasks, treat, and prevent diseases of the adult population. Graduates are awarded the qualification of “General Practitioner”, which allows them to occupy positions in the primary care unit for providing medical diagnostic assistance. Graduates of the Program will develop a range of skills and competences, among them: preventing the occurrence and (or) spread of diseases, their early diagnosis, identifying the causes and conditions for their emergence and development, and also aimed at eliminating the harmful effects on health human environmental factors, conducting preventive medical examinations, clinical examination and dispensary observation, carrying out anti-epidemic measures, determining patient's main pathological conditions, symptoms, disease syndromes.

Students are taught by qualified professors, medical practitioners and employees of medical institutions. Advantages of the academic program include practical exercises at clinical sites, Perinatal Center, FEFU Medical Center and other health care organizations. Students can be also certified at the FEFU Accreditation and Simulation Center.



Master Program “Improving Healthcare Outcomes in Chronic Diseases”

Major Public Health

Partners University College Dublin (in cooperation with the University of Pavia, Siberian Medical University, Medical University of Hanoi, the First Sechenov Moscow State Medical University)

Brief Information The student will receive advanced experience in organizing medical care for socially significant diseases of the cardiovascular system, metabolism, degenerative diseases of the brain. After graduation, students will be able to work as leaders of leading clinics, hospital departments, and work in analytical centers related to the health care system. The purpose of the Master program: to prepare a specialist who has the necessary competencies to assess public health and the factors determining it; systems ensuring the preservation, strengthening and restoration of public health; organizational-medical and management technologies in medical and pharmaceutical activities; trends in the development of health care in foreign countries and in Russia.

Master Program “Cybersecurity”

The program is providing students with knowledge about international business experience and managing projects. Students will study features and the role of major events happening in the Asia-Pacific Region, trends of forming and developing of different social nets (trade, politics, and economics) in the modern international business. This program is designed for students interested in acquiring management skills for cooperation with international partners and studying the best world practices in conducting and managing the business for sustainable development of the company. Graduates of the Program will also develop skills needed for launching and implementation of the project, taking into account practices of international projects. Competitive advantages of the Program include ability to work in a team for the development of project ideas and project development. Through teamwork and interaction both between team members and teachers, students will receive practical skills in project design, management decision-making in its implementation, effective control over its regulation, and in project change

Master Program “Aquatic Biological Research”

Brief information The educational program is aimed at meeting the demand of academic and sectoral institutions, higher and secondary educational institutions, various centers for monitoring environmental pollution, nature reserves and other forms of protected areas. Graduates of the Program will be able to work as research associates and teachers at leading Russian and foreign universities and research institutes, as well as officers in public environmental protection and control services.

Among its core disciplines the Program offers the following modules: Science as a Creative Process, Advanced IT for Data Analysis and Simulation, Environmental Toxicology and Chemistry, Control of Natural Water Quality, Biodiversity Measuring and Monitoring, Microbiological Indication of Marine Water and Deep-Sea Ecosystems etc.
